- we will follow any changed plans/routines when arriving at school or leaving the school grounds.
- we will follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising
- we will follow instructions on who we can socialise with at school
- we will move around the school in a sensible way and follow instructions (for example, one-way systems, playtime areas, queuing)
- we will be aware of expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- we will tell an adult if we are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- we will not share any equipment or other items including drinking bottles
- we will follow guidance and expectations about breaks or play times, including where we may or may not play
- we will only use the bathrooms that are designated to our bubble
- we will not cause physical harm to any of our friends, we understand that this behaviour will not be tolerated.
- we will have a clear understanding regarding the rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person. We understand that this behaviour will not be tolerated.
