You will never be treated unfairly or with discrimination.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make everyone aware of the rules and ensuring all children follow them</li> <li>• Treat everyone fairly and with dignity</li> <li>• Listen to you and giving you time</li> <li>• Consider those who have not yet had the chance to shine and providing them with opportunities</li> <li>• Give people confidence to join in and share ideas with others</li> <li>• Use Kagan activities to ensure equal opportunities in activities</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Speak kindly to others</li> <li>• Think about what you want to say before saying it</li> <li>• Listen to other people's opinions and respect that they may be different to your own</li> <li>• Be confident in sharing your opinions</li> <li>• Access information in a safe way</li> <li>• Follow the e-safety rules</li> <li>• Access a range of books from the school library to support learning</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Article 13</b></p> <p>You have the right to find things out and share what you think with others, by talking, drawing, and writing or in any other way unless it harms or offends people.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Encourage children to speak freely but with care to respect other's feelings</li> <li>• Provide opportunities for children to discuss ideas and express their thoughts and opinions</li> <li>• Provide access to information in a safe way</li> <li>• Teach and reinforce the e-safety rules</li> <li>• Provide a range of books from the school library to support learning</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Respect the religion and beliefs of others</li> <li>• Listen carefully so that you are clear on information you have been given</li> <li>• Be proud of your beliefs</li> <li>• Talk confidently about what you now and believe</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Article 14</b></p> <p>You have the right to choose your own religion and beliefs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide opportunities to learn about the religions and beliefs of others</li> <li>• Encourage discussion and support gathering of information on the cultures of other countries</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand that our friends will have other friends as well</li> <li>• Use playtimes and lunchtimes to enjoy the company of others</li> <li>• Never tell anyone that they can't join in</li> <li>• Enjoy the range of clubs and activities in school</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Article 15</b></p> <p>You have the right to choose your own friends and to be part of a group as long as it isn't harmful to others.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Always encourage positive behaviour</li> <li>• Treat everyone equally</li> <li>• Help to fairly resolve any difficulties that may arise</li> </ul>
